The Community Storage Initiative: A New Approach to Energy Storage

The briefing, organized by the Office of Senator Amy Klobuchar (D-MN), provides an introduction to how the energy sector can use tried and true household technologies to help meet consumer energy needs in a new energy era.

The Community Storage Initiative was launched earlier this year by the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association (NRECA), Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC), Edison Electric Institute (EEI), American Public Power Association (APPA) and Peak Load Management Alliance (PLMA). It has been organized as a grassroots effort to develop a community-based energy storage marketplace that works for everyone, from electric utilities and technology providers to end-use customers and their communities.
